Using symbols is using an abbreviated or conceptual representation. As a group of frequencies that can counteract, empower and transform they work very well. There is a warning, when you set something in motion, you may get more than you bargained for. If used to try and CHANGE someone else's mind you might find it a waste of effort, having said that sending good or loving energy to someone will work a treat.

Some symbols are best used in situations, some for clearing the air so to speak and yet others to encourage higher energies to get things moving. Some symbols will really only work well when used on yourself, bearing this in mind if you choose your symbol well, pair it with some candle magic, throw in some crystal magic and then encourage your spell (affirmation) to make a complete energy you might be more than pleasantly surprised at outcomes.

Animate an inanimate object - awaken an inanimate object to the energy, this enables you to effectively place energy into an item for someone to hold or wear so it can be used over a longer period of time. Or you can use it with your candle, your affirmation (spell) and crystal effectively energizing them.


Particular value for those who have trouble sustaining energy, plans, etc.

Eeeftchay is one of those symbols that can seem to come back at you, if you have been fooling yourself, not honest with others or your intention with your spell, it will be revealed to others, as well as yourself. This symbol is almost like a key, containing both structure and penetrating accuracy

Use when a person cannot see the truth in their situation does not accept responsibility or is blaming others for where they are in life, where you feel someone is deceiving you or when you feel that intentionally or otherwise, the truth is being missed.

cho ku rei





This is a symbol to empower an intention, energy flow, or an individual: Enhances the power of the universe. In our own lives, bring forward what is needed to manifest. It can be used to focus universal energy on a particular space, or place, in the present or in the future.

Use on any area of the body or chakra, can be used into any situation or environment where you want an increase in something. Not recommended in situations dominated by angry or overly stimulated energies

And so on, mathematically the equation would look like this $3 \times 3 \times 3 \times 3 = 81$



Ta Ku Rei




A symbol of power and enhancement the inclusion of the infinity pattern creates an expansion to the infinite finishing at the heart Chakra, useful for bending of time and bringing a sense of rightness everything in its right place and space, grounding you in the groove. As with all lemniscate what goes out comes back in, meets its match and can be used. When it is an expanding lemniscate as this one is it expands or compounds the effects. This means that there are steady improvements over time. Use at the heart chakra, for those who think time is against them, who feel out of sync or that their timing is off.

Gateway to the soul via the heart chakra: creating an expansion in all aspects of unconditional love, compassion, opening the heart to others. Increasing the capacity of an individual to share themselves from an inner level

can be used to the power of 3, 7 and 9

Used when an individual is compromised in the area of love, may experience difficulty having appropriate love relationships, or releasing hurt from the past, where there is resentment or blame and an unforgiving or hard nature, can be used on self or another

It is not effective when used in situations, it is worthwhile remembering that it may encourage some compassion in another when used that way, but that may not go further than a thought, also if the situation is not one where they are not being dis-compassionate but you are not getting what you want. It will be ineffective

This is a very popular symbol and embraces fertility, this is for birthing ideas, can release hormones, sexual desire, communication, ideas, inner or latent talent and basically anything that is not flowing in the way that it could. If two people stop talking this will get them started, if you have an artists or writers block this will release it and so on.

Se He Kei



You can't go past this one for releases, clearing barriers to expression on any level and can be used to calm another person or you increase the flow of energy without increasing pressure. Is particularly helpful when there is a lack of awareness of the issue, or those involved don't know what is wrong.

Use into any environment, situation or directed to another person to help them say what they need to say, bear in mind there is no guarantee it will be what you want to hear, having said that knowing releases one from false hopes and fears.

It can be used to release trapped ideas, in a group to encourage free communication and sharing knowledge

Healing on any level really where you are not present: including, past and future lives, relationships or situations.


Is of use where hurt in a relationship or situation cannot be released in the present. This symbol goes to the essence of things that may be causing problems, targeting the root cause. It will always be right on target even if you are unsure of core issues, origins or a specific need.

This is a symbol that will release the heart of the matter in question and moves across time to do so. Issues often just seem to disappear when this symbol is used.

Being creative is sadly overlooked in relationships, manifestations and day to day life. You cannot expect to get something different by continuing to do the same thing again and again. Creativity is not just about baking a cake, making music or painting a picture. It is about being creative in ones thinking, this allows for growth and manifestations that move beyond expectation and even dreams. Encouraging creativity is to encourage a new train of thought, a new process, a new way of doing something, fresh ideas and transforming old patterns. 

This symbol I bought through. It creates change where change is required. This is not a symbol to use lightly as the consequences are not often what you might expect or even hoped for, how it works is determined by WHAT needs to change to create potential.

Use where there is stagnation, where attitudes or stubbornness reign, where you want rapid movement into a new direction or belief.

You can use this symbol for others to create a change in the way they interact with you. This symbol simply brings around massive and rapid change targeting the aspect that need to change.
